## **OVERVIEW**

Like the other Walters Golf courses in Las Vegas, the Desert Pines Golf Club offers golfers a uniquely themed experience unlike any other in the City of Entertainment. Here, within 15 minutes of the heart of The Strip or 10 minutes from downtown, golfers are transported to the Carolina sandhills. This Dye-designed layout features over 4,000 mature trees lining lush fairways, with whitesand bunkers protecting large bent grass greens. Water plays an important role in navigating this special golf experience that tends to reward good course management skills over power off the tees. Keeping the ball in play is the key to a good score here. Adding to the “Carolina” experience is the southern hospitality offered by the staff.



### **#16 Great Basin**

Guests will find that hospitality on the course or in the fully stocked golf shop, which sells name brand golf apparel and equipment and all the other necessities including balls, gloves, socks, souvenir items and even features a display of celebrity-autographed balls. 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# *The Desert Pines*

## *Practice Center*

The Desert Pines Practice Center is the areas only two-tiered, climate controlled facility featuring an automatic ball delivery system so golfers needn't bend over to tee up each new practice ball. The 58 hitting stations are under cover from the rain and direct sunlight. The Center is also climate controlled so it is cooler in the summer and warmer in the winter and lit for nighttime practice - staying open until 10:30 p.m. in the winter and 11 p.m. in the summer. There are also two teaching bays with instruction available from PGA Master instructors.



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# Directions

3415 East Bonanza : Las Vegas, NV 89101

From the Airport or Strip, take I-15 North to US-95 South. Take US-95 South to the Eastern Avenue exit. Turn left on Eastern Avenue and proceed two lights to Bonanza and make a right. Desert Pines is located about a 1/4 mile on the right.

From Downtown, head north on Eastern to Bonanza and turn right

 From the Airport or Strip, take I-15 North to I-95 South. Take I-95 South to the Eastern exit. Make a left onto Eastern and proceed two lights and make a right onto Bonanza. Desert Pines is located about 1/2 mile on the right.
